



During the American Revolution, the legal separation of the thirteen colonies from Great Britain in 1776 actually occurred on July 2, when the Second Continental Congress voted to approve a resolution of independence that had been proposed in June by Richard Henry Lee of Virginia declaring the United States independent from Great Britain's rule. After voting for independence, Congress turned its attention to the Declaration of Independence, a statement explaining this decision, which had been prepared by a Committee of Five, with Thomas Jefferson as its principal author. Congress debated and revised the wording of the Declaration, finally approving it two days later on July 4. A day earlier, John Adams had written to his wife Abigail:

#### SHCA



The second day of July 1776, will be the most memorable epoch in the history of America. I am apt to believe that it will be celebrated by succeeding generations as the great anniversary festival. It ought to be commemorated as the day of deliverance, by solemn acts of devotion to God Almighty. It ought to be solemnized with pomp and parade, with shows, games, sports, guns, bells, bonfires, and illuminations, from one end of this continent to the other, from this time forward forever more.

Adams's prediction was off by two days. From the outset, Americans celebrated independence on July 4, the date shown on the much-publicized Declaration of Independence, rather than on July 2, the date the resolution of independence was approved in a closed session of Congress.

Historians have long disputed whether members of Congress signed the Declaration of Independence on July 4, even though Thomas Jefferson, John Adams, and Benjamin Franklin all later wrote that they had signed it on that day. Most historians have concluded that the Declaration was signed nearly a month after its adoption, on August 2, 1776, and not on July 4 as is commonly believed.

By a remarkable coincidence, Thomas Jefferson and John Adams, the only two signatories of the Declaration of Independence later to serve as presidents of the United States, both died on the same day: July 4, 1826, which was the 50th anniversary of the Declaration, Jefferson even mentioning the fact. Although not a signatory of the Declaration of Independence, James Monroe, another Founding Father who was elected as president, also died on July 4, 1831, making him the third President who died on the anniversary of independence. The only U.S. president to have been born on Independence Day was Calvin Coolidge, who was born on July 4, 1872.





#### **Grilled Steak Fajitas**

how to turn steak, peppers and onions into delicious, restaurant -worthy grilled fajitas.

Bring 2 tablespoons of unsalted butter to room temperature.

Place a 12-inch cast-iron skillet on one side of a gas grill and preheat the grill to high.

Alternatively, preheat a large grill pan over high heat and a 12-inch cast-iron skillet over high heat.

3 tablespoons olive oil, plus more for the grill or grill pan

2 tablespoons plus 1/4 teaspoon chili-lime seasoning, such as Good & Gather<sup>TM</sup> Chili Lime Seasoning Blend

2 cloves garlic, grated

2 limes

Kosher salt and freshly ground black pepper

Two 8-ounce New York strip steaks, about 1 inch thick, such as Good & Gather<sup>TM</sup> USDA Choice New York Strip Steak

3 bell peppers (about 1 1/2 pounds), stemmed, seeded and sliced 1/2 inch thick, such as Good & Gather<sup>TM</sup> Tri-Colored Bell Peppers

1 medium onion (about 8 ounces), halved and sliced 1/2 inch thick

2 tablespoons unsalted butter, at room temperature

Eight 6-inch corn tortillas

Salsa, for serving



#### Grilled Vegetable Panzanella

Cut one 12-ounce loaf country bread into 1-inch-thick slices. Grill over medium heat until marked, 2 minutes per side; cut into cubes. Cut 1 each zucchini, yellow squash and red onion into 1/2-inch-thick slices; cut 1 red bell pepper into quarters. Brush the vegetables with olive oil, season with salt and pepper and grill until tender, about 5 minutes. Chop the vegetables and toss with the bread cubes, 1 pint halved cherry tomatoes, 1/2 cup torn basil, 1/2 cup olive oil and 1/4 cup red wine vinegar. Season with salt and pepper. Top with shaved ricotta salata.

#### Sweet and Sour Couscous-Stuffed Peppers



Ingredients

Deselect All

2 medium carrots, cut into chunks

2 stalks celery, cut into chunks

1 large shallot, cut into chunks

1 1/2 tablespoons olive oil

1/2 pound lean ground beef
2 tablespoons plus 4 teaspoons tomato paste
1/3 cup chopped fresh parsley, dill or a combination
1/3 cup golden raisins
2 tablespoons red wine vinegar

Kosher salt

4 red, yellow, orange or green bell peppers or a mix of colors, halved lengthwise and seeded

1/2 cup whole wheat couscous

3/4 cup grated asiago cheese

Preheat the oven to 450 degrees F. Pulse the carrots, celery and shallots in a food processor until coarsely chopped.

Heat 1 tablespoon of the olive oil in a large nonstick skillet over medium high. Add the chopped vegetables and cook, stirring frequently, until light golden and soft, 8 to 10 minutes. (Add a splash of water if the mixture begins to stick.) Add the ground beef and 4 teaspoons of the tomato paste and cook, breaking the mixture up with a wooden spoon, until browned, about 4 minutes. Add 1/2 cup water, the parsley, raisins, 1 tablespoon of the vinegar and 3/4 teaspoon salt. Bring to a simmer and cook until most of the water is absorbed and the mixture gets saucy, about 1 minute. Let cool slightly.

Meanwhile, toss the pepper halves with the remaining 1/2 table-spoon oil in a microwave-safe bowl. Cover with plastic wrap and microwave until the peppers are pliable, 10 to 12 minutes. Carefully uncover the bowl and pour out any liquid that has accumulated.

Stir the couscous into the beef mixture. Whisk together the remaining 2 tablespoons tomato paste, 1 tablespoon vinegar and 3/4 cup water in the bottom of a large baking dish.

Carefully transfer the peppers to the baking dish cut-side up and fill each pepper with the couscous mixture. Sprinkle with the cheese. Cover with foil and bake until the peppers are tender and the stuffing is hot, 20 to 25 minutes. Serve warm or at room temperature drizzled with the tomato cooking liquid.
